

REMINDERS

Per our City ordinance, it is unlawful to mow your grass onto the City street. Please help keep our storm drains free of grass and debris!

Need a building permit? The City of Hull requires a building permit for patios, new construction, accessory buildings and remodeling projects with structural changes. Building permit forms are available online (cityofhull.org) or at the City Office.

Your sump pump is not allowed to drain into the sanitary sewer system. It may drain into the storm sewer system, your property or the street. See our City website for a detailed explanation. (cityofhull.org)
