## ORDINANCE NO. 380

## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF HULL, IOWA, BY ADDING A SECTION CHAPTER \$55 PROHIBITING THE KEEPING OF BEES IN CITY LIMITS

**BE IT ENACTED** by the City Council of the City of Hull, Iowa:

**Section 1. SECTIONS ADDED.** The Code of Ordinances of the City of Hull, Iowa, is amended by adding a new Section 55.06, and renumbering the current Section 55.06 and following sections accordingly:

**55.06 BEEKEEPING.** It is unlawful for a person to keep bees or other apiary products within the City except by written consent of the Council or except in compliance with the City's zoning regulations.

**Section 2. REPEALER**. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

**Section 3. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE**. If any section, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

**Section 4.** WHEN EFFECTIVE. This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its final passage, approval, and publication as provided by law.
