## **ORDINANCE NO. 395**

## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF HULL, IOWA, BY AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 383 OF THE CITY OF HULL REGARDING COLLECTION FEES FOR COLLECTION OF SOLID WASTE

## BE IT ENACTED by the City Council of Hull, Iowa:

**Section 1. SECTIONS AMENDED.** The Code of Ordinances of the City of Hull, Iowa, is amended as follows:

a) Section 106.08 is hereby amended by striking the section in its entirety and substituting the following new section:

## SECTION 106.08 COLLECTION FEES

**COLLECTION FEES.** The collection and disposal of solid waste and recyclable materials as provided by this chapter are declared to be beneficial to the property served or eligible to be served and there shall be levied and collected fees therefore in the following amounts:

- 1. **Residential Premises**. One city-approved 65-gallon container shall be collected weekly per each residential premises inside the city limits at a rate of \$15.30 per month until June 30, 2025. On and after July 1, 2025, the rate is increased to \$15.80 until June 30, 2026. On and after July 1, 2026, the rate is increased to \$16.30. All additional containers placed for collection shall be collected and disposed of and will be charged an excess disposal charge as shown on the City's schedule of rates as approved by the Council. No container shall exceed 75 pounds.
- 2. **Regular Rural Customers**. Pickups for individuals living outside the city limits that are on a weekly schedule will be charged according to the size dumpster and number of pickups per month at a rate as shown on the City's schedule of rates as approved by the Council.
- 3. **Rural Customers (on call).** Pickups for individuals living outside the city limits not on a regular schedule will be charged according to the size dumpster and number of pickups per month at a rate as shown on the City's schedule of rates as approved by the Council.
- 4. **Commercial, Industrial & Residential Dumpster Customers**. Customers will be billed according to the number and size of dumpsters, and frequency of pickup as shown on the City's schedule of rates as approved by the Council. All business customers must own their dumpster(s).
- 5. **City Owned Dumpsters**. A rental fee as shown on the City's schedule of rates as approved by the Council applies to the rental of all City-owned dumpsters.
- 6. **Additional Items Pricing**. Property owners will be assessed any costs paid by the City to the landfill for additional items according to the most current pricing list received by the City from the landfill.

All fees are due and payable under the same terms and conditions provided for payment of a combined service account as contained in Section 92.04 of this Code of Ordinances. Solid waste collection service may be discontinued in accordance with the provisions contained in Section 92.05 if the combined service account becomes delinquent, and the provisions contained in Section 92.08 relating to lien notices shall also apply in the event of a delinquent account.

**Section 2. REPEALER.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

**Section 3. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE.** If any section, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

**Section 4. WHEN EFFECTIVE.** This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its final passage, approval, and publication as provided by law.
